Horseshoe Lake 2008 21 hole layout

On or across all fences, roads, paths, parking lots, and the drainage canal is OB. On a stationary picnic table, or it's concrete base, is OB. Horseshoe lake is OB.

Hole #19 has an alternate tee for the players in the "open" division.

19. Par 4 -new 08 "OPEN" players will play from the longer tee, all other divisions will play from the front tee. The land where hole number 21 is located is considered OB for this hole. *Note below
20. Par 3
21. Par 4 Mandatory right of the marked tree. Missed = Retee,



*Horseshoe lake acts as a river. When the overflow of water is such that the lake drains across fairways 5, and out past Spring street, the shoreline is divided into two parts. Hole #5 plays across from one section to the other, but for hole # 19 throwing across (to land by hole 21) is not allowed.
